

# Assisted Living Facility Physician Medication Orders

FACILITY: The President Madison Inn

Effective December 28, 2005, according to the standards and regulations for licensed assisted living facilities in the Commonwealth of Virginia (22VAC 40-71-400 D) , the following is required for all physician's medication orders: Physician's orders, both written and oral, for administration of all prescription and non-prescription medications and dietary supplements shall include the name of the resident, the date of the order, the name of the drug, route, dosage, strength, frequency of administration, and identify the diagnosis, condition, or specific indications for each drug. In addition, each order will include the quantity of medication prescribed, and the number of refills allowed. (per Board of Pharmacy regulation)
